INSTRUCTIONS REGARDING DESIGNATION OF VOTER BY CORPORATIONS OWNING LAND OR INTEREST IN LAND IN COLUSA BASIN DRAINAGE DISTRICT

- 1. A corporation acts by resolution in designating the party it wishes to vote in CBDD elections. If the corporation owns an undivided interest in the land with other owners, the Corporation must by resolution along with the other owners designate the person to vote.
- 2. The Resolution adopted by the Corporation should be signed by the Secretary, have the seal imprinted or stamped on the Resolution, and the Resolution delivered to the District at least forty (40) days before the election to include the designee upon the voter list.
- 3. The Corporation Resolution, which can use the form included below, should state substantially the following:
